Class Photographs

We had earlier arranged for photographs to be taken for all classes. The class photographs are ready for pupils to place order. Gifted Education Programme (GEP) Screening Test for P3 pupils (Fri, 24 Aug)

The GEP Screening Test will be conducted on Fri, 24 Aug during curriculum time.

Lower Primary Sports Day (Tue, 28 Aug)

We will be having our Lower Primary Sports Day in school on Tue, 28 Aug for P1, P2 and P3 pupils. School hours remain the same for the day. All P1, P2 and P3 pupils are to come in their PE attire. The pupils will have their Sports activities in the Hall from 7.45 a.m. to 9.45 a.m. Lessons will go on as usual for the other levels on this day.

Teachers' Day Celebration and Early Dismissal (Thu, 30 Aug)

We will be having our Teacher's Day Celebration in school on Thu, 30 Aug. The Teachers' Day concert will start at 10.15 a.m. Pupils are to come in school uniform. We encourage pupils to show appreciation to their teachers. Pupils who would like to show appreciation to their teachers can make a simple Teachers' Day card. There is no need for the pupils to buy presents for teachers.

The 2 recesses would be brought forward by 1 period to enable the Teachers' Day programme to start at 10.15 a.m. Please note the timing for the 2 recesses on Thu, 30 Aug:

- P1, P3 and P4 : 9.15 a.m. to 9.45 a.m.
- P2, P5 and P6 : 9.45 a.m. to 10.15 a.m.

Please note that school will end at 11.45 a.m.

Teachers' Day Holiday (Fri, 31 Aug)

Teachers' Day which falls on Fri, 31 Aug is a school holiday.

September Holidays (Sat, 1 Sept to Sun, 9 Sept)

The 1-week school holidays which will be from Sat, 1 Sept to Sun, 9 Sept. The Primary 6 pupils will come back on Thu, 6 Sept and Fri, 7 Sept for PSLE revision lessons. A separate letter with more details will be issued to P6 pupils. School will reopen on Mon, 10 Sept.
