


Dear parents of P1 students

### Arrangement for First Day of School for Primary 1 students on Tuesday 4 January 2022

- 1. All Primary 1 (P1) students will report to school from Tue 4 Jan 2022. Do note that only **one** parent will be allowed to accompany your child into the school on that morning.
  - a. **For parents who are vaccinated,** please ensure that you bring along your mobile phone. You may use either the TraceTogether App or the HealthHub App to show your vaccination status. Please take note that if you are not able to show us your vaccination status, you will <u>not</u> be permitted to enter into the school.



2. For parents who are not vaccinated (including those medically ineligible for the vaccines), you will be required to show a photo of a negative ART result performed within 24 hours prior to entry. Kindly ensure that your name, date and time of the ART test is written on the result device.





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3. Please take note that we have different reporting times for the P1 classes so that social distancing measures can be adhered to.

### For Group 1:

- 1) One parent and child can enter the school via Gate A or Gate C. Vaccination screening and temperature scanning will take place at these gates.
- 2) Once clear, both parent and child can then proceed to the school hall (level 2). You may remain in the Hall for the flag-raising ceremony but kindly observe Safe Management Measures by ensuring you are at least 1m apart from other parents. After the flag-raising ceremony, you will be ushered to the classrooms for a briefing by School Leaders. This will take place from 7.50 to 8.25 am.
- 3) After the briefing is completed, parents will be dismissed in small groups and exit the school via Gate C only.

### For Group 2:

- 1) One parent and child can enter the school via <u>Gate A only</u> (this is because we will have parents from Group 1 leaving the school via Gate C after their briefing). Vaccination screening and temperature scanning will take place at these gates.
- 2) Once clear, both parent and child can then proceed to the school hall (level 2). You may remain in the Hall for the flag-raising ceremony but kindly observe Safe Management Measures by ensuring you are at least 1m apart from other parents. After the flag-raising ceremony, you will be ushered to the classrooms for a briefing by School Leaders. This will take place from 8.50 to 9.25 am.
- 3) After the briefing is completed, parents will be dismissed in small groups and exit the school via Gate C only.

#### If you are driving and would like to alight your child at the school:

- a) Drive into the school via our entry gate. Only your child and the designated accompanying parent can alight at the drop-off point. Please exit the school safely and quickly so as not to hold back the traffic in car park area. **Parking within the school compound is for staff only.**
- b) Please note that the main gates will be opened at the following times for the different groups to reduce congestion:
  - a. For Group 1 : From 7.00 7.35am
  - b. For Group 2: From 8.00 8.35am
- c) If you are also the accompanying parent, please park your car at the nearby HDB Multi-Storey Car Park (Blk 404A), which is situated next to the school. You can then enter the school with your child via Gate A or C if your child is in group 1 or via Gate A only if your child is in group 2.



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
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### 4. What if your child takes the school bus to school but is only meant to report by 8.35 am?

We are aware that some parents may accompany their child on the school bus and arrive in school between 6.45-7.15 am. If your child is only scheduled to report by 8.35 am, please proceed to the canteen (holding area) in the first instance. We have staff on duty there. Do wait at the canteen and please remember to practise social-distancing until about 8.20 am. Our staff will inform you when you and your child can proceed to the School Hall. .

### 6. <u>Dismissal time for Primary 1 classes (only from Tue 4 Jan 2021 to Fri 14 Jan 2022):</u>

To help P1 students get used to dismissal routines, there will be staggered early dismissal timing for P1 classes only for the first two weeks i.e. 4 Jan to 14 Jan.

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- 7. During the respective dismissal time, please wait for your child at the pre-arranged dismissal points. Please do remember to practise safe-distancing while waiting for your child. Students who are taking the school bus or attending after-school care will have different arrangements they will be brought to the buses and after-school care centres by teachers on duty.
- 8. <u>Dismissal time for all Primary 1 classes with effect from Mon 17 Jan 2022</u>:

All P1 classes will be dismissed at 1.20 pm wef **Mon 17 Jan 2022**. We have staggered dismissal times for the different levels in light of the COVID-19 situation and the P1 classes are the first level to be dismissed.

9. Briefing by School Leaders on 4 Jan 2022 (Tue)

We look forward to touching base with you on Tue, 4 Jan 2022. We will keep the briefing short (about 30 min) and all seats will be placed at least 1m apart from each other. The briefing will be held at the Level 4 classrooms. These briefing sessions are <u>not compulsory</u> as there are a number of parents who are already used to our school's SOPs and dismissal procedures. The information shared can also be found in our school's website under "P1 e-Orientation 2021". For parents who are not attending the briefing, you can leave the school via Gate C, once the flag-raising ceremony in the School Hall is over.

10. We would like to remind all parents that other than recess, there is also a snack break time for all students. For the snack break, your child may want to bring along a simple dry snack such as buns, sandwiches, biscuits or fruits. The snack break will be for about 10 min and for P1 classes, it will be at 12.00 pm. If your child/ward prefers not to eat a snack, he/she can use the time as a rest break.
