Letter from the Principal

Dear Parents

We warmly welcome parents of P1 classes (2022) to Parents Gateway. Each month, you will receive a letter from me, providing you with updates of major school events and activities. This would be the last letter for 2021 as the school academic year draws to a close on Friday, 19 November 2021.

1) Deepavali (Thu 4 Nov)

We would like to wish all our Hindu parents and students and all who celebrate Deepavali a most "Joyous and Happy Deepavali".

2) Year-End Administration Day (Thu 11 Nov)

Our staff will be processing the students' results and preparing the result slips on Thursday 11 November. On this day, we will also be conducting the promotion and class allocation exercise for 2021. All students need not come to school on this day.

3) Primary 6 Graduation E-Ceremony (Wed 17 Nov)

Our P6 Graduating E-Ceremony will be held on Wednesday 17 November in our school. In line with present Safety Management Measures (SMM), it will be held virtually and parents will not be invited for this year's ceremony.

4) Issue of Report Books for Primary 4 (Fri 12 Nov) and Primary 4 SBB E-Meeting (Mon 15 Nov)

Reports books for Primary 1, 2, 3 & 5 will be issued on Wednesday 17 November. Parents are requested to safe-keep the report books over the year-end school holidays and return the endorsed report book when school reopens for the new academic year on Tue 4 Jan 2022.

In light of Safety Management Measures (SMM), this year's P1 Orientation will be fully virtual. The E-P1 Orientation will take commence on Sat 20 Nov and last until mid-January 2022.
