Dear Parent,

We welcome our school community back to school for Term 4, the last term of the year. We would like to keep you updated on the events in the coming weeks.

PSLE Listening Comprehension (Fri, 15 Sept)

The PSLE Listening Comprehension will be conducted on Fri, 15 Sept. All our Primary 6 pupils will be in school to take the PSLE Listening Comprehension. The school canteen will be open for recess (break between the English Language LC and Mother Tongue LC). Pupils from all other levels are **not** required to come to school on this day. Teachers have assigned homework to ensure that pupils continue with their learning at home.

PSLE Written Papers (Thu, 28 Sept to Wed, 4 Oct)

Our P6 pupils will be sitting for the PSLE written papers starting from Thu, 28 Sept. On PSLE days, P1 to P5 pupils will continue to come to school and observe the same school hours.

Mid-Autumn Festival (Fri, 29 Sept)

We will be celebrating Mid-Autumn Festival on Fri, 29 Sept. We would like to thank the parents who have registered their children (P1 to P3) for the event. It will be an opportunity for our children to experience the traditions of the festival as well as for families to have an enjoyable time. All are welcome to join in the event. Registration will start at 6.00 p.m for children with tickets to collect door gifts. The programme will last from 6.30 p.m to about 8.30 p.m. We look forward to celebrating Mid-Autumn Festival with your family.

Children's Day Celebrations (Thu, 5 Oct) and Children's Day School Holiday (Fri, 6 Oct)

We will be celebrating Children's Day on Thu, 5 Oct with a Games Carnival and Children's Day Concert. The concert will take place at 10.45 a.m. This is our Rainbow Day 4 and our Primary 1 classes will be putting up performances in the hall. As part of Rainbow Day, pupils can come to school in their home clothes. Although pupils are free to put on their casual attire, they should dress smartly and be in their school shoes. School will start and end at the usual time.

Children's Day which falls on Fri, 6 Oct is a school holiday.

Semestral Assessment 2 (SA2):

Mother Tongue e-Oral examinations for Primary 5 pupils

We will be conducting Mother Tongue e-Oral examinations for Primary 5 pupils on Mon, 18 and Tue, 19 Sept, after curriculum time in the afternoon. Under the implementation of the revised formats for the PSLE MTL/FMTL, our P5 pupils will sit for Mother Tongue e-Oral examinations at PSLE next year. Details are in the letter issued to P5 parents.

Oral Examinations for P3 to P5 pupils

The Oral Examinations for P3 to P5 pupils will be conducted after school in the afternoon. Schedule as follow:

- Mon, 9 Oct : All P3 classes (EL and MT) and 5 Diligence, 5 Integrity, 5 Respect (EL only)
- Tue, 10 Oct : All P4 classes (EL and MT) and 5 Perseverance, 5 Compassion and 5 Responsibility (EL only)

Paper 1 and LC will be conducted during curriculum time.

- English Language Paper 1 and LC: Fri, 13 Oct
- Mother Tongue Language Paper 1 and LC: Mon, 16 Oct

Other SA2 Written Papers for Primary 2 to 5 pupils

The written papers for the 4 subjects will take place from Fri, 27 Oct to Wed, 1 Nov. The detailed SA2 timetable and scope of assessment for each level will be provided in a separate letter.

Deepavali Public Holiday (Wed, 18 Oct)

Deepavali this year falls on Wed, 18 Oct. Hindu staff and pupils will be released early at 10.15 a.m. on the eve of Deepavali on Tue, 17 Oct.
