Endeavour Primary 10th Anniversary Celebrations

This year marks the 10th Anniversary of Endeavour Primary. To celebrate this milestone, our school will be holding two key celebratory events as follows:

❖ Open House cum Homecoming Carnival (14 July 2018, Sat)

The school's Open House cum Homecoming Carnival will be hosted in two segments:

- Open House (9.00a.m. – 11.30a.m.)

The Open House will be held for parents of pre-school children who are interested to visit our school and to learn more about our school. There will be showcase of our curriculum and programme and hands-on learning experiences to engage the children.

- Homecoming Carnival (11.00a.m. – 2.00p.m.)

In conjunction with our 10th Anniversary celebrations, all students, parents, and former staff and students are welcome to join us in our celebrations at Endeavour Primary. This will be a fun-filled day with carnival games, food and most importantly, opportunities for one another to mingle and reminisce good old times. The event will start at 11.00a.m. in Endeavour Hall with the launch of the Endeavour Fabric (EDP murals consisting of mosaics collectively painted by students and staff of EDP) and the Endeavour Orchid (an orchid hybrid nurtured by P5 students through the Orchid Hybridisation programme). Gracing this special event as the Guest-of-Honour will be Mr Chia Soo Keng, former Principal of Endeavour Primary.

❖ Endeavour Celebrates! Musical (24 November 2018, Sat)

As part of our 10th Anniversary Celebrations, our school will also be staging a musical in Endeavour Hall. The title of the musical is 'Alice in Wonderland', an age-appropriate story that features a child's sense of wonderment, and growing-up journey and adventures. Auditions have been conducted and the selected students will be participating in training sessions during the June holidays and in Semester Two.

We will be organising "EDP Cares Flag Day" on 24 May, Thursday to develop compassion in our pupils for the less fortunate in our society. Pupils will learn more about the visually handicapped and the SAVH. There will be activities for the pupils to participate in during recesses. A Flag Day booth will be set up from 9.30 a.m. to 1.45 p.m. in the school canteen to collect donations for SAVH. There will also be a booth set up for sale of Touch Art items made by SAVH, with the motto "to help the visually handicapped help themselves". Parents could show their support by encouraging their children to donate to the less fortunate in our society at "EDP Cares Flag Day".

Parent-Teacher Meeting (PTM) for All Levels (25 May, Fri)

Thank you for your response to book timeslots through MC-Online to meet the Form Teachers at the coming PTM on 25 May, Fri from 8.00 a.m. to 3.30 p.m. The session is intended for teachers to have a discussion with you on your child's learning progress and holistic development.

Please take note of the following arrangements for the PTM:

- Lessons will be suspended as all teachers will be involved in the PTM. P1 and P2 pupils will attend the PTM with their parents. Pupils from all other levels are not required to attend the PTM. Please note that pupils will need to be in school uniform when they are attending the PTM.
- Upon arrival, please proceed to your child's classroom to meet the Form Teacher at the timeslot you signed up for.
- All Mother Tongue teachers will be stationed in the School Hall. If you would like to meet up with your child's Mother Tongue teacher, please find out who he or she is before making your way to the hall. It is expected that queues will form and we seek your understanding and patience in waiting for your turn.
- Parents of each pupil will have about 10 minutes with each teacher. If further discussion is needed, the teacher will follow up with a telephone call on another day. We seek your understanding on this.
- There will be a tea break (10.00 a.m. to 10.30 a.m.) and a lunch break (12.30 p.m. to 1.30 p.m.) for teachers. Teachers will not be meeting parents during these timeslots.
- Report books for P3 to P6 pupils will be issued at the session. For P1 and P2 pupils, their Holistic Assessment files will be returned to parents.
- Parents who are not coming for the PTM can collect report books from the General Office during the first 2 weeks of the June holidays.
- Parents are to sign the report books and return them to the Form Teachers when school reopens.

Eat with Your Family Day 2018 (25 May, Fri)

This year, Eat With Your Family Day 2018 will take place on 25 May, Fri. This event serves to remind us of the importance of spending quality time with our loved ones regularly. Through the simple ritual of having a family meal, the event encourage families to eat together regularly.
